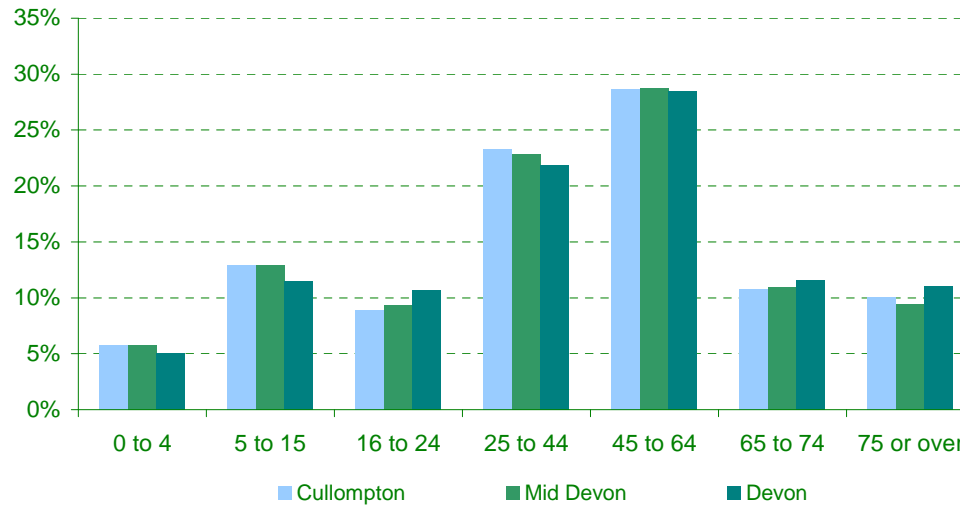

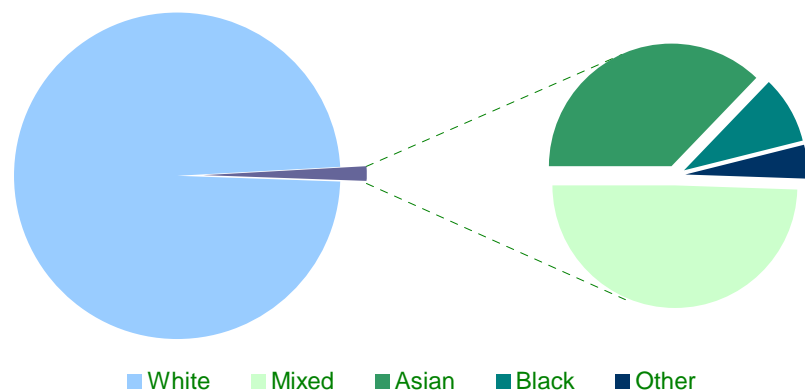

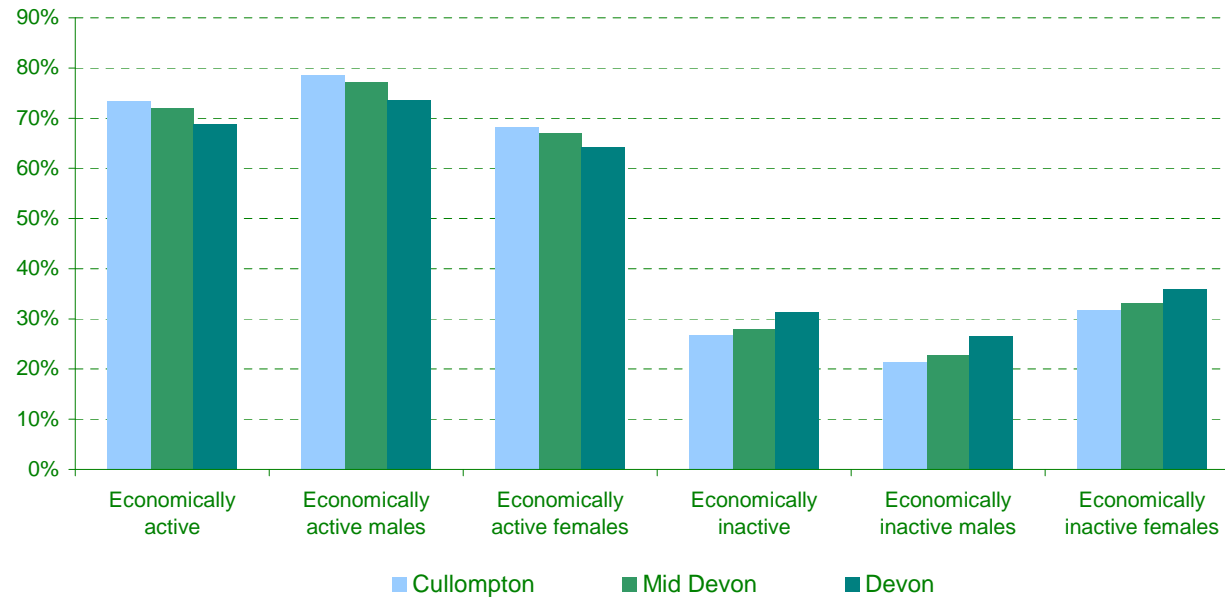

Notes

1. Health

Due to a change in the way the health question was phrased the 2001 and 2011 figures are not directly comparable.

2. Qualification level

Level 1: 'O' level passes; 1+ CSE/GCSE any grades; NVQ level 1; Foundation GNVQ.

Level 2: 'O' level passes; 5+ CSEs (grade 1's); 5+ GCSEs (grades A-C); School Certificate;
1+ 'A' levels/'AS' levels; NVQ level 2; Intermediate GNVQ.

Level 3: 2+ 'A' levels; 4+ AS levels; Higher School Certificate; NVQ level 3; Advanced GNVQ.

Level 4/5: First degree; Higher degree; NVQ levels 4 and 5; HNC; HND; Qualified Teacher Status;
Qualified Medical Doctor; Qualified Dentist; Qualified Nurse; Midwife; Health Visitor.

3. Occupancy rating

An occupancy rating of -1 or less indicates that a household has 1 (or more) too few rooms (or bedrooms).

A one person household is assumed to require three rooms (two common rooms and A bedroom)

Where there are two or more residents it is assumed that they require a minimum of two common rooms plus one bedroom for:

- i. each couple (as determined by the relationship question)
- ii. each lone parent
- iii. any other person aged 16 or over
- iv. each pair aged 10 to 15 of the same sex
- v. each pair formed from a remaining person aged 10 to 15 with a child aged under 10 of the same sex
- vi. each pair of children aged under 10 remaining
- vii. each remaining person (either aged 10 to 15 or under 10).

4. Deprivation

The dimensions of deprivation are:

Employment: Any member of the household aged 16-74 who is not a full-time student is either unemployed or permanently sick.

Education: No member of the household aged 16 to pensionable age has at least 5 GCSEs (grade A-C) or equivalent AND no member of the household aged 16-18 is in full-time education.

Health and disability: Any member of the household has general health 'not good' in the year before Census or has a limiting long term illness.

Housing: The household's accommodation is either overcrowded (occupancy indicator is -1 or less);
OR is in a shared dwelling OR does not have sole use of bath/shower and toilet
OR has no central heating.
